 - **Goats** - Friday, March 3 beginning at 7:30 am
 - **Barrows** - Saturday, March 4 beginning at 7:30 am
 - **Gilts** – Sunday, March 5 beginning at 7:30 am
 - **Premium Sale** - Monday, March 6 beginning at 5:00 pm.
- Members may not be a correspondent on a day in which they have an animal to exhibit.
- Correspondents should have experience posting to Facebook, Twitter, or Instagram.
- Correspondents will be acting as an official representative of NWDJLS and will be held responsible for all social media updates made on their assigned day.
- Correspondents must have a 3.0 current GPA or higher.
- Correspondents will be asked to participate in a social media training prior to show and a follow up survey after the show regarding their experience
